



## **Waldorf Education Growing in Mexico**

Teachers, staff, trustees, and parents from Waldorf schools and institutes in Mexico gathered in November in San Miguel de Allende for the annual Waldorf Pedagogical Conference. Hosted by Colegio Rudolf Steiner on their beautiful campus, the conference featured a rich variety of artistic and pedagogical workshops.

The keynote speaker, Rosa Baracio, an experienced and respected Waldorf educator in Mexico, addressed the four temperaments in children. AWSNA Leader of Programs and Activities, Michael Soulé, participated and met with teams of teachers from schools in Mexico City, Cuernavaca, Tlaxcala, San Miguel, Guanajuato, Vera Cruz, Puerto Morales, Playa del Carmen, Aguascalientes, Guadalajara, and Valle de Bravo.

These growing schools share the Waldorf movement in Mexico with many young initiative schools. Last summer over 100 teachers participated in courses offered by Centro Antroposofico in Cuernavaca. This February, the Cuernavaca school will be the first Mexican Waldorf school to complete an accreditation with AWSNA.
